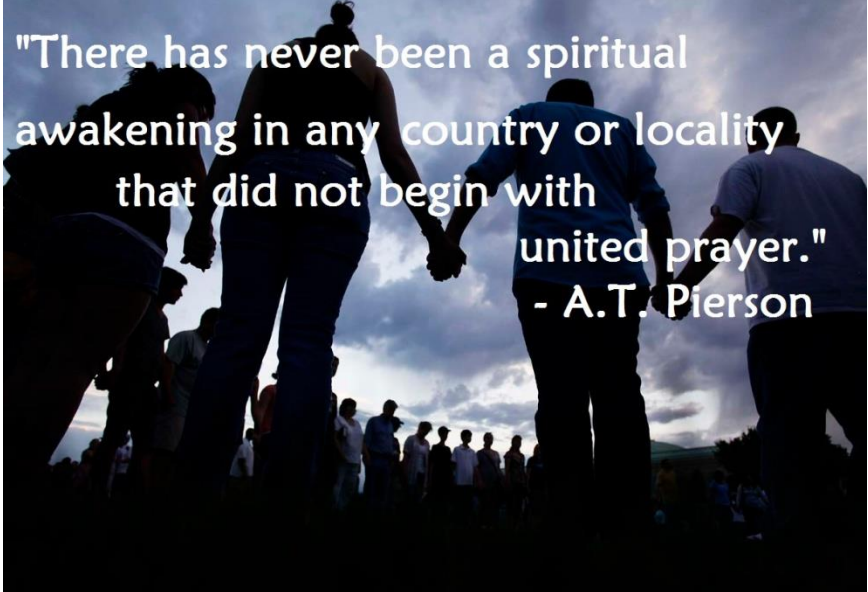

MOREOVER HE MUST HAVE A GOOD TESTIMONY AMONG THOSE WHO ARE OUTSIDE, LEST HE FALL INTO REPROACH AND THE SNARE OF THE DEVIL. I TIMOTHY 3:1-7

- Protection for Pastor Tom and his family, and insight and strength for all those that assist him. (Hebrews 13:15-17)

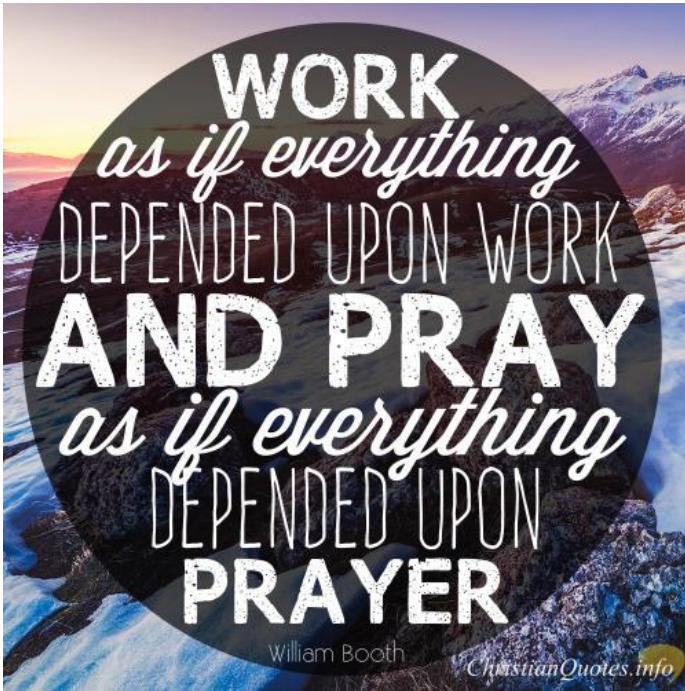
Pray for our CHURCH CAMPUS

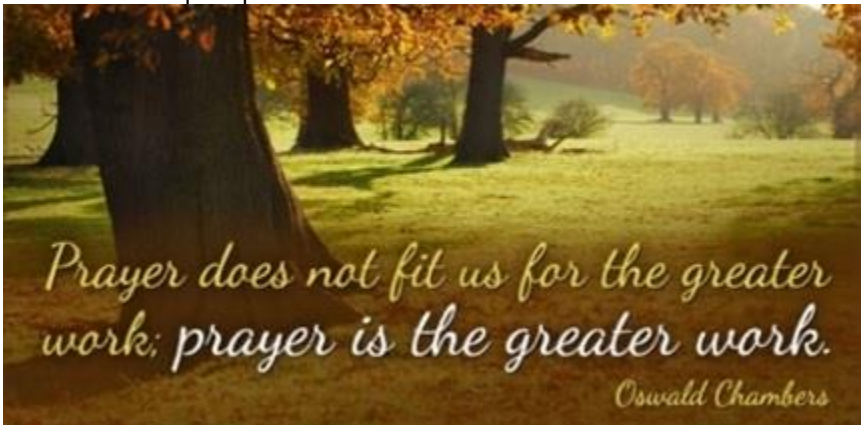

MARRIED ADULTS

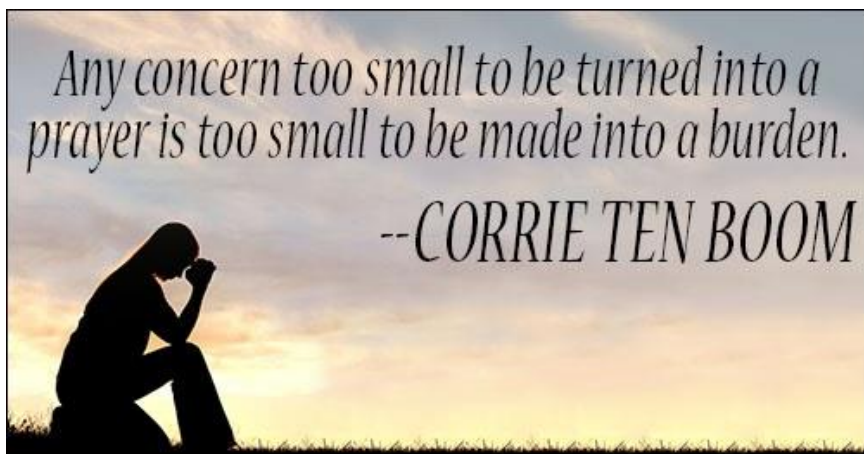

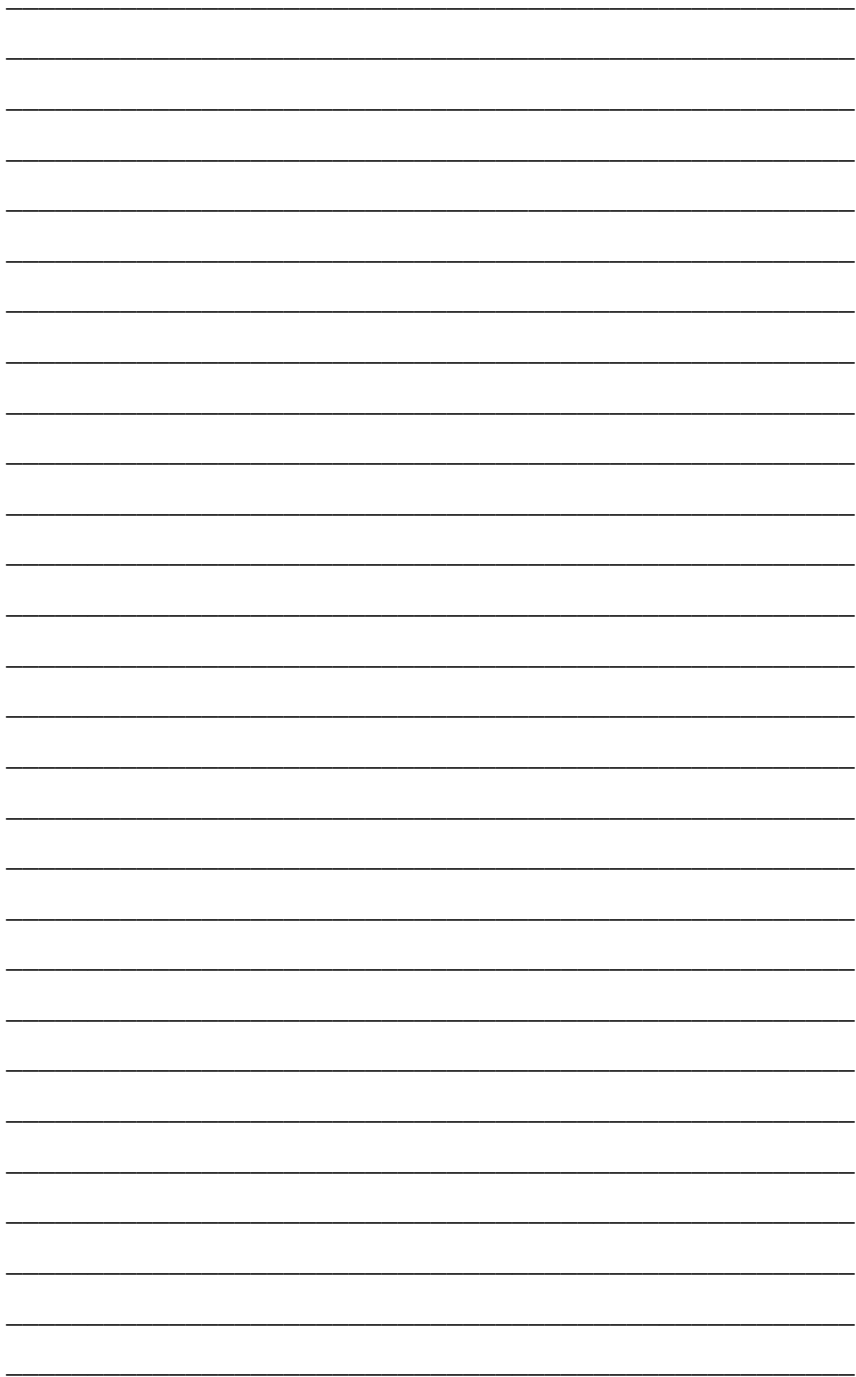

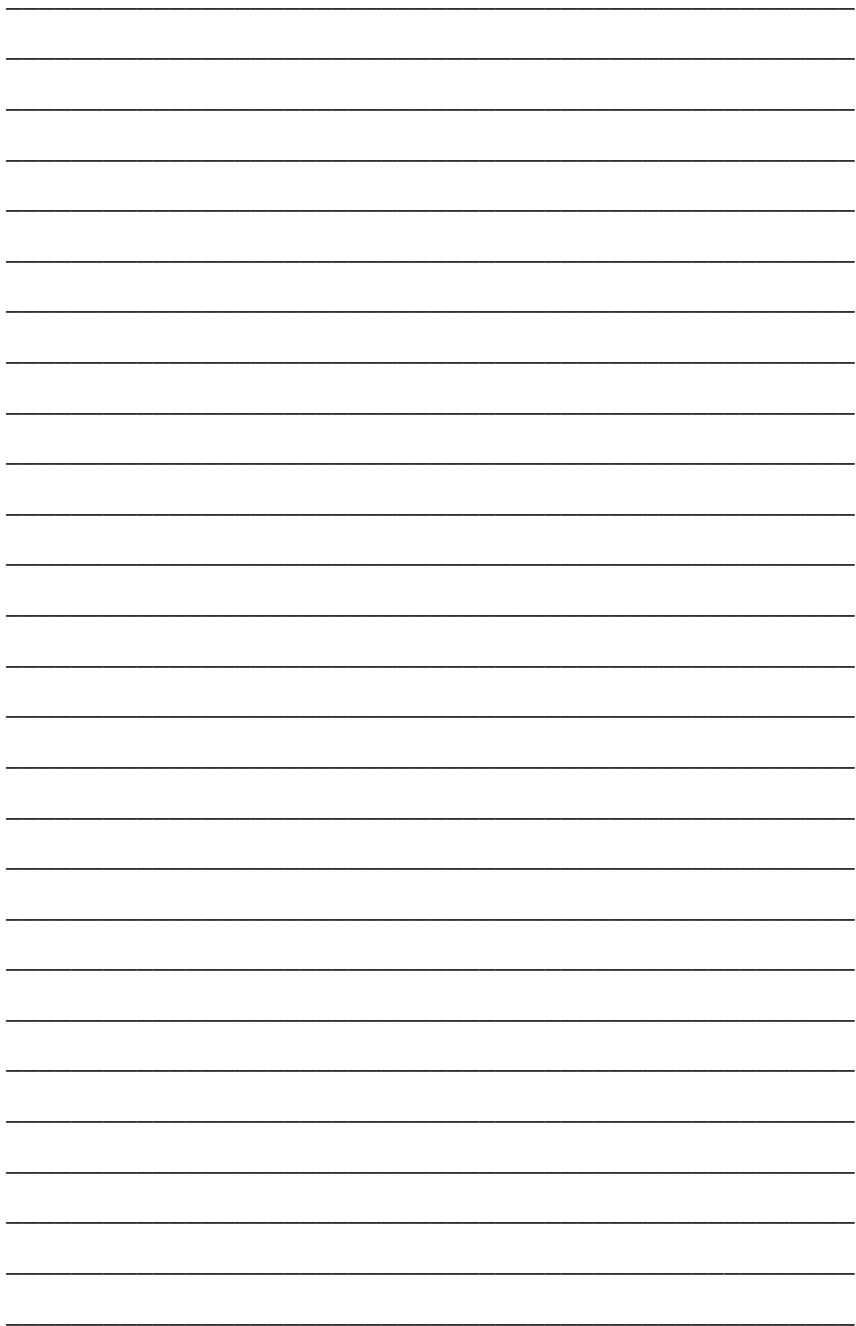

Simple Story – What is Yours?

Pray that God will use your story to bring people to Him.

Example: My name is Clayton. My mom was 14 when she got pregnant and 15 when she gave birth. Her parents wanted her to abort me, but she gave me up for adoption. I was raised in a small town in SC. My adopted parents always took me to church, and I thought that because I went to church I was a Christian. But at 14 through the testimony of my parents and by a drug dealer at my Christian School who was radically converted to faith in Christ, quit doing drugs, and started FOLLOWING Jesus, I decided that I wanted a relationship with Christ. I asked Jesus to forgive me of my sin and save me, and I automatically felt this call that I was suppose to tell people about Jesus. For last 30 years, I have told people my story. I am married to a lovely woman of God, and we have 2 great kids, and I want them to know and experience a relationship with Christ. Because Jesus changed my story, I want their story to compel people to follow Jesus.

What do you believe about Jesus? What's your story?

Why not become somebody's "because" that brings them to Jesus?!

Why not decide . . . I want somebody to become a Christian because I told them my story. I want someone to put their faith in Christ because I told them how He saved me. I want someone to come to church with me because I invited them to an event. I want 3 of my friends to come join in our church fellowship because I prayed for them all year and asked them to come with me. I want kids to know that Jesus is real because I don't cheat on my science test. I want people at work to know that Jesus is real because of the way I conduct my life! Become somebody's "because". Your story could be what brings somebody to Jesus, and He has a way of changing your story – He writes the best stories.
